



DAILY SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES

- We will be strictly following the state guidelines and restrictions (available to everyone at reopeningri.com) and on our website at <https://rifac.com/rifac-covid-19-update/>
- All campers should **complete an at-home screening** prior to attending camp. Please utilize the screening tool on our website at the link above.
- Camp sections will be limited to 15 people.
- All students/visitors will be logged in and screened upon arrival, including the use of a non-contact scanning thermometer.
- **Students should arrive between 8:45 and 8:55am. Camp will end promptly at 4pm.**
- **Drop-off/ Pick-up Procedure:** We will have a car drop-off line for parents so students can be screened one at a time and parents will know they have been cleared to enter. For pick-up, parents should arrive at least 5 minutes prior to the end of the camp time and wait in the parking area. We will be staggering dismissals to maintain distancing measures.
- **Facial coverings will be required to be worn by students.** Special mask inserts to fit inside fencing masks will be distributed to camp students who experience trouble using their facial coverings inside their masks.
- Only students and staff will be allowed inside the club unless it is absolutely necessary that one parent/guardian accompany the student.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and available for all campers to use during the day.
- Waiting areas and changing rooms will be closed. Students should come dressed in their athletic clothes and sneakers (students can wear shorts as long as they bring long sweatpants with them to put on when it is time to fence.)
- Water fountains will not be accessible. **All students should bring their own water bottles** and snacks (and lunch for full-day camps).
- Distancing guidelines will be followed during all camps. Fencing will be allowed, but with strict limitation of close distance actions. We will continue to suspend any hand shaking/fist bumping or any contact with other students and staff.
- All shared RIFAC gear will be thoroughly cleaned between each use.
- Beginner fencers (and experienced fencers who do not yet have their own gear) will be issued their own set of RIFAC gear to be used exclusively by them for the week of the camp. The gear will be kept at the club. This gear will not be shared during the camp week.
- While we will still have our weekly team and individual tournaments at the end of camp, unfortunately, parents and visitors will not be able to attend this year and these special events will be for camp participants only.
